


Current Phase		Scope of Work
Construction		The project involves the rehabilitation and widening of the existing bridge. Rehabilitation will be achieved by improving the seismic resistance of the structure. Widening of the deck is proposed along the down stream side of the bridge with minimal alterations to the bridge expected along the upstream side. As part of the funded project, eight foot wide sidewalks will be incorporated, and bike traffic will utilize added shoulders across the bridge to join the Los Angeles River (LAR) Bikepath network. Additional funding acquired for the concurrent construction of a bikeway underpass to connect a dedicated bikepath along the LAR.
